Perfect for a chilly winter morning and suitably enjoyed in the relaxed comfortable atmosphere of the The Coffee Roasting Company at Lourensford Wine Estate. Open 7 days a week from 9am to 5pm – you can watch coffee being roasted, learn about coffee, and buy freshly roasted ground coffee to take home.

The Lourensford wine estate is a 45 minute drive from Cape Town on the N2 going to Somerset West. Take Exit 43 and at the intersection at The Lord Charles turn right into Main Road Somerset West. At the fourth traffic light turn left into Lourensford Road. After 4 km turn left, after Erinvale Golf Estate and follow the signs to Lourensford Estate. GPS Latitude:-34.07197 Longitude: 18.88863.

The estate is dog friendly and hosts an all weather covered harvest market on Sundays from 10am to 3pm. Here you can enjoy live music, freshly prepared delicious food, fresh produce, clothes and crafts.

There is something for everyone - art galleries, wine tasting (of course), Healey

cheeses, and the Millhouse restaurant. There is also a new beer made on the premises called ABRU.
